Adult Piano Adventures Classics Book 1 celebrates great masterworks of Western music, including symphony themes, opera gems, and classical favorites. The melodies of Bach, Beethoven, Brahms, and other master composers are arranged at just the right level for adult beginners and for those who are returning to the keyboard. Section 1 features piano arrangements with minimal hand position changes, and many selections include an optional duet part. Section 2 introduces the I, IV, and V7 chords in the key of C major, harmonizing themes such as Sibelius's *Finlandia*, Schubert's *The Trout*, and Mendelssohn's *Spring Song*. Section 3 presents the primary chords in the key of G major, with arrangements of Vivaldi's *Autumn* (from *The Four Seasons*), Mozart's theme from *The Magic Flute*, Liszt's *Liebestraum*, and more.

If you are looking for music to program as an alternative to the full band playing for a graduation ceremony, please check out this arrangement. Are you asked to provide music for graduation ceremonies at lower grade levels other than senior graduation? Rather than require the full band to perform for these special ceremonies, focus on a small brass ensemble or the brass section

of your band. This arrangement is similar to March No. 1, *Land of Hope and Glory* (check out that arrangement, too), the traditional prelude played as graduates promenade prior to their ceremonies. Marches 1 and 4 could easily be paired as a prelude and recessional. This arrangement is scored for brass quintet (2 trumpets, Horn, and 2 trombones). However, it includes parts for Tuba and T.C. Baritone. The Horn in F part doubles the 2nd Trombone and Tuba and T.C. Baritone double the 3rd Trombone providing flexibility of use. The range in the first trumpet part extends to a high A. Following a 21-measure, fanfare-type introduction in Concert Key of F Major, the traditional trio of the *Pomp and Circumstance* March No. 4, *Song of Liberty*, is introduced in Concert Key of Bb Major. The trio can easily be repeated as often as necessary to allow time for graduates and guests to recess. This is a relatively easy arrangement, playable by capable middle level and high school players as a quintet or a brass ensemble with varied number of performers. The purchaser of this volume is free to make copies of the parts for rehearsal and performance purposes. So, once you've prepared the parts for the first rehearsal/performance, file this volume away and it will be there, complete, without missing parts, for years to come.

He describes how politicians who conceded the vote to millions more men disregarded women so utterly that female suffragists' public protest bordered on terrorism. He depicts a ruling class that fell prey to degeneracy and scandal. He analyses a national psyche that embraced the motor-car, the sensationalist press, and the science fiction of H. G. Wells, but also the nostalgia of A. E. Housman.
