Obwohl das Benchmarking-Verfahren noch sehr jung ist, ist es trotzdem bereits in diversen Wirtschaftsbranchen bekannt. Von den Anfängen in den 80er Jahren des 20. Jahrhunderts hat es sich bis heute stetig weiterentwickelt. Mittlerweile hat sich das Benchmarking auch in den Managementtagen großer Unternehmen etabliert. Verstärkt wird die Notwendigkeit dadurch, dass der Service eine immer größere Bedeutung hinsichtlich der Kaufentscheidung beim Kunden einnimmt. Dieses Buch betrachtet dieses Gebiet im Detail und verknüpft das Verfahren des Benchmarking mit dem Service in der Automobilindustrie. Da die Ansprüche der Kunden ständig wachsen und nach mangelfreien Produkten und Leistungen verlangen, ist eine hohe Kundenzufriedenheit hinsichtlich der Qualität und Zuverlässigkeit von Serviceleistungen eine unverzichtbare Voraussetzung zur Erhaltung und Steigerung der Wettbewerbsfähigkeit des jeweiligen Herstellers. Ein guter Service lohnt sich: Nach Preis und Produkt ist Service der wichtigste Faktor bei der Kaufentscheidung der Kunden. Die Kosten, die während der Lebensdauer eines Nutzfahrzeuges für Reparatur, Wartung und Ersatzteile anfallen, sind in etwa so hoch wie die Kosten für die Anschaffung des Fahrzeuges. Das führt dazu, dass der Service bei der Positionierung eines Fahrzeuges im Markt eine immer größere Bedeutung erlangt. Genau diese Entwicklung konnte ich in den vergangenen Monaten in meiner beruflichen Tätigkeit als Mitglied eines Benchmarking-Teams bei der Volkswagen AG feststellen. Aus Herstellersicht sind der Service und der Teilevertrieb neben den Finanzdienstleistungen die wichtigsten Profitsäulen. Verschiedene Umstrukturierungen im Service-Bereich, insbesondere bei der Geschäftsmarke Volkswagen Nutzfahrzeuge, zeigen deutlich wie wichtig es ist, diese Marktentwicklung zu nutzen und vorhandene Potenziale auszuschöpfen. Bevor sich Potenziale ausschöpfen lassen, ist es notwendig, diese über Informationen strukturiert zu ermitteln, denn wer sich auf dem Markt behaupten will, braucht brandaktuelle Informationen über seine Konkurrenten. Die richtigen Informationen zur richtigen Zeit können Konkurrenten

beim Kunden aus dem Rennen werfen und die eigene Position stärken. Leider befinden sich bedeutende Wettbewerbsinformationen oftmals verstreut in verschiedenen Abteilungen. Sie müssen in aufbereiteter Form zur Verfügung gestellt werden, damit diese in Geschäftsleitung, Vertrieb, Marketing, Produkt-Management, Entwicklung und Produktion sinnvoll genutzt werden können. Welches Instrument kann dieses Problem lösen und zugleich die vielfältigen Anforderungen erfüllen? Die Antwort lautet Benchmarking. Benchmarking ist ein Verfahren, welches kontinuierlich durchgeführt werden kann. Darüber hinaus ist es sehr individuell einsetzbar.
