Ce manuel de mathématiques a pour objectif de développer la capacité des élèves à s'initier à la démarche scientifique. Ce manuel est complété par un cahier d'exercices qui permet aux élèves de mettre en application les notions essentielles et par un site compagnon qui propose des documents complémentaires au manuel, des exercices supplémentaires (dont certains interactifs) ainsi que des vidéos explicatives et des exemples de solutions aux « défis Scratch » du manuel.
